WHAT A G.I.F.T!

When we brought the inaugural Global Ireland Football Tournament to Ireland alongside Notre Dame & Navy in 2012, I had no idea that 11 years later we would be back for the fourth time. It feels so good to return, this time with 6 competitive teams from 4 different states of America, one from nearby England sponsored by the NFL, and a squad of local Ireland players joining the GIFT event for the initial time. The student athletes representing each school and team are here to proudly demonstrate and test their abilities on the football field against similarly motivated and trained teenagers. They are also in Ireland to experience the unique culture of this island nation, to learn about its rich history, to share moments with locals and to visit iconic sports venues.

Since the creation of Global Football in 1996 It has always been my goal to provide life-enhancing opportunities for student athletes, coaches and supporters. While we have developed and produced competitive games around the world, the land of my maternal ancestors, Ireland, remains the perfect nation in which to bring the competitors, their families and supporters. Plus, for the second time our teams will be showcased alongside the historic University of Notre Dame and the US Naval Academy.

What an honor this is for Seton Hall Prep, New Jersey; Baylor School, Tennessee; Bonner & Prendie High of Philadelphia and Community School of Naples, Florida. The administrators and coaches of these highly respected institutions took bold steps many months ago to make this possible. They are to be congratulated for their vision and leadership, directing the team efforts needed within their communities. Certainly, the American Football Ireland (AFI) organization has raised its level of visibility by being a valuable member of the GIFT showcase. It is personally special to have the NFL Academy here as the league has continued its international development by requesting to have this select team involved here. I vividly remember the 1996 meeting in New York where I explained to NFL Properties why I believed a U18 Global Jr Championship would make sense. Eleven Super Bowls later that program had highlighted and driven football development across Europe, Mexico, Japan, Canada, Panama and the USA.

It is noteworthy that we are joined in Energia Park by a former Naval Academy quarterback, Admiral William Byrne, who led his Midshipmen for three seasons and set numerous records before embarking on his illustrious career as a Naval officer. The recently retired Admiral will handle coin toss duties for the first two GIFT games. Handling that role for the 7:00pm game will be Daniel Martin Rooney, grandson of the former US Ambassador to Ireland, Dan Rooney, who tossed the GIFT coin in 2012. The current Pittsburgh Steelers Director of Business Development and Strategy is heading up the Steelers' efforts in the NFL Global Markets Program by taking on Ireland. His presence at the GIFT final game of the day will further allow him to witness firsthand the passion the Irish have for 'Football'; The True Global Sport.

GIFT HONORARY CHAIRMAN

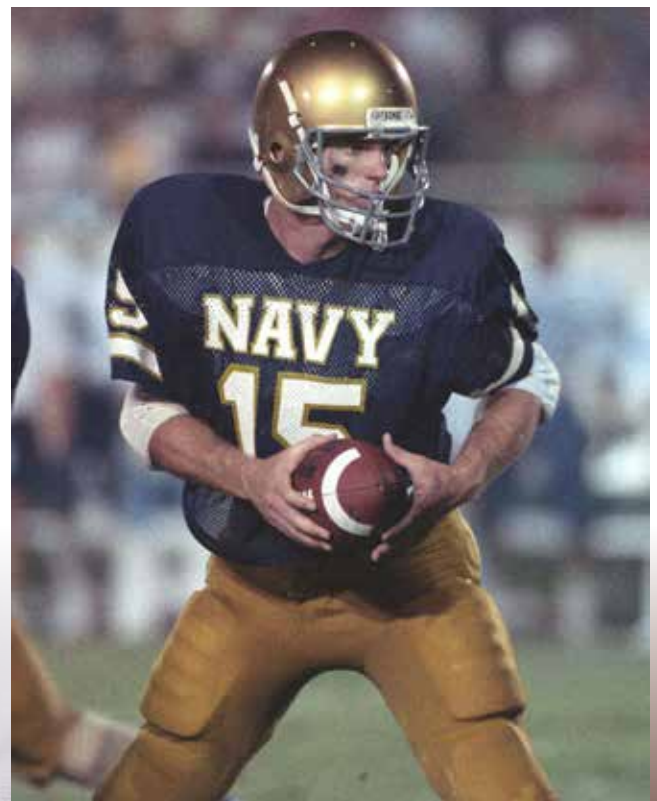
ADM WILLIAM BYRNE

Global Football is proud to announce that Irish descendant Rear Admiral William Byrne, U.S. Navy (Ret.), will be assisting with this year's Global Ireland Football Tournament, joining us in Dublin. GIFT will be held at Energia Park on August 25 featuring six teams from the United States, UK and Ireland. Founder and President of Global Football said "It is an honor to welcome Admiral Bill Byrne to Ireland as Honorary Chairman of the GIFT 2023 High School Showcase. His record as a Naval Academy quarterback was outstanding, only overshadowed by his brilliant career as a Naval officer. My goal is to introduce him to the young student athletes who will be competing in Energia Field August 25th, then have him address the competitors and supporters at our Awards Luncheon in Croke Park the day of the Navy-Notre Dame game. When he tosses the coin for the GIFT Tripleheader, he will be following the lead of our initial honoree, Ambassador Dan Rooney, Pittsburgh Steelers owner who at the time was US Ambassador to Ireland."

Bill played football for the Naval Academy where he still holds several school passing records, but is most proud of having been elected by his teammates as their team captain his senior year. Bill served our nation brilliantly for 35 years as a Surface Warfare Officer and culminated his career in senior positions at the Pentagon. Among his many posts held globally, he was Commandant of Midshipmen at the US Naval Academy from 2013-15. In addition to his many service awards, he was honored by the National Football Foundation in 2015 with their Distinguished American Award. His wife Amy is his Naval Academy classmate and four of their five children are also Naval Academy graduates.

"High school football was the foundation of every success I enjoyed at the Naval Academy and in the Navy. As a proud Irish-American, I'm humbled by this honor and I'm thrilled to help showcase this rich American tradition once again to our friends and family in the Emerald Isle."

This will truly be a momentous occasion for the young men participating in this year's GIFT and we are honored to have Bill assisting us with the coin toss and awards luncheon.

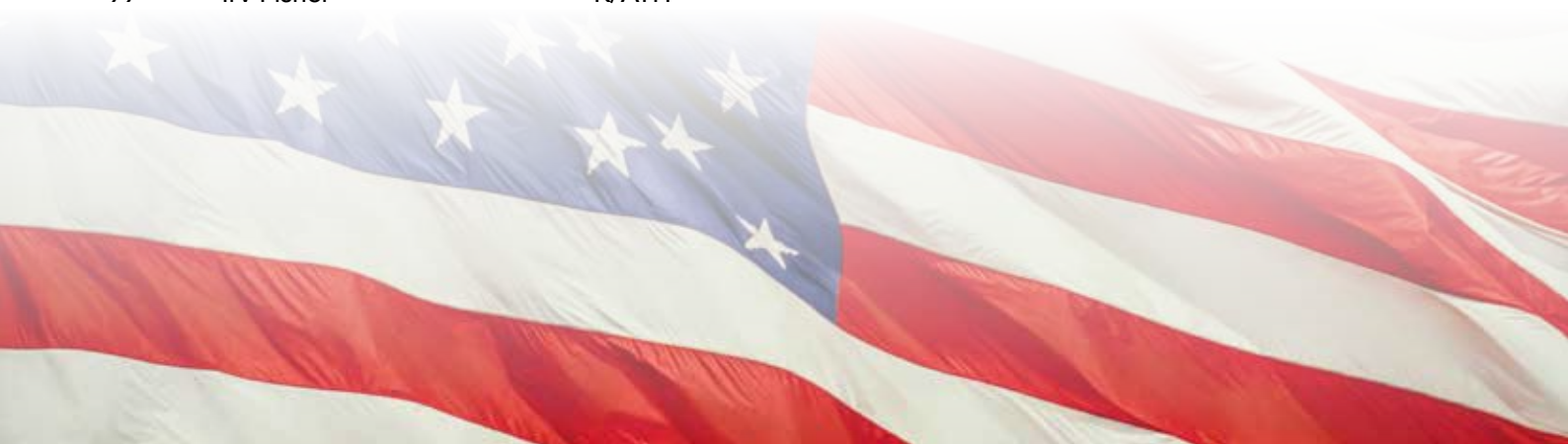

Global Football is humbled to honor an Irish man who should be recognized, among all his other accolades, as the Guardian of the Global Ireland Football Tournament - G.I.F.T.
Mr. Brian Mullins.

A GAA icon who helped lead his Dublin County Senior team to four All-Ireland football championships from 1974-1985. Brian played with a passion and ruggedness which has long been the style and stamp of his St. Vincent's Gaelic Football club. Post-playing career he focused on education at both the high school (college) as well as the university levels, serving ultimately for 22 years as the University College Dublin Director of Sport. He was steadfast in his belief that Athletics and Academics should be woven together wherever possible, that every student should work to excel in both, especially during those developmental years.

During the initial planning stages of the initial GIFT event during spring of 2011, Patrick Steenberge was introduced to Brian Mullins, who quickly grasped the concept of this nascent event concept. That very day he walked Patrick into the office of then-GAA head Paraic Duffy at Croke Park, he suggested this dream could be a powerful force for further uniting the teenage youth of Ireland and America.



From that day until the untimely day of Brian Mullins' passing in September 2022, he steadily helped guide, assist and support the GIFT staff and supporters in their efforts. He helped Patrick overcome numerous obstacles, directed the right Irish people towards GIFT leaders, and always greeted the event participants representing 26 school teams thus far, with a hearty "You are most welcome!"
